Connect ThemOne Click

In Claude, open **Settings** → **Connectors**, find **Canva**, click Connect and sign in. That is the whole setup. Official and free.

02

Describe The DesignPlain English

Type what you want, like **design me a bold Instagram post, black background, navy accent**. Claude sends it to Canva and you get 4 versions to pick from.

03

Edit And PostIn Your Canva

Every design lands **in your Canva account**. Open it, tweak anything, export or post. Claude can also find, resize and export your old designs.
